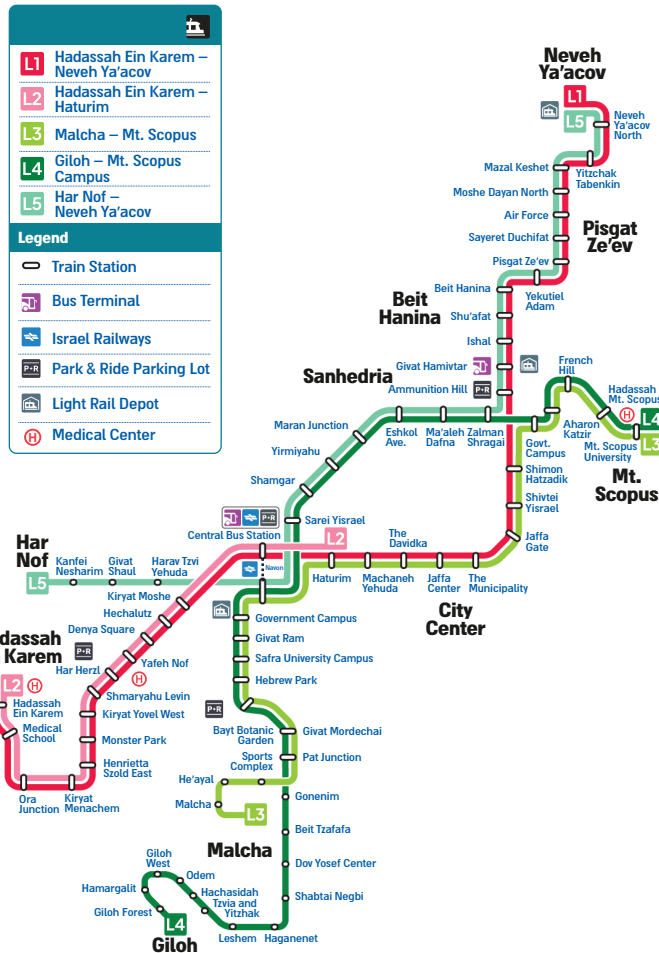


Transitioning from a Track to a Network

Dear Residents,

We take pleasure in informing you that the Kfir Light Rail Train Company in Jerusalem, will commence trial runs along the service line, on the section between the Turim Light Rail Station and the Malcha neighborhood [in stages].

During the course of the trial runs, the train will not carry passengers.



In the coming days until regular operation commences, all hours of the day and night.

Pay particular attention to the safety directives and the rules of conduct in the vicinity of the train and the railway tracks.



Traveling along the railway tracks is prohibited and endangers you and the surroundings!



Beware of electricity! Maintain a safe distance from the overhead electricity lines along the railway tracks



The railway tracks belong to the train, not to the pedestrians!



The train runs quietly – do not speak on your mobile phone and remove earphones when crossing the tracks
